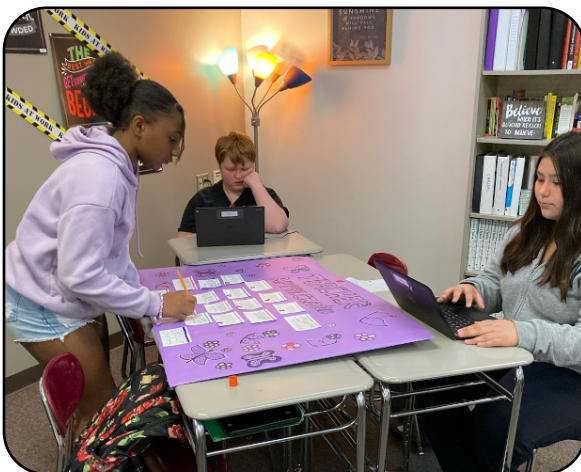
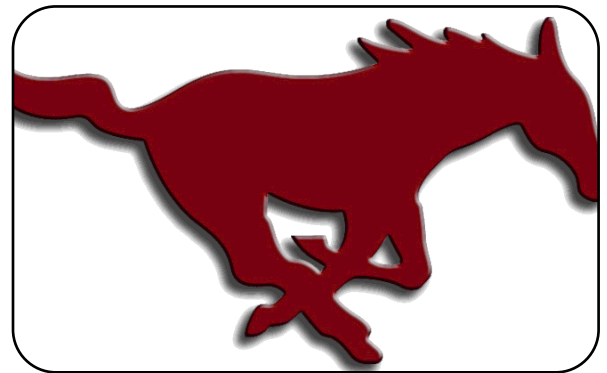


LMS Orchestra
